Income of both parents from all sources should not exceed ₹. 2.0 (Lakh) per annum. Applications for Post Matric Scholarship are to be submitted on-line through the URL www.scholarships.gov.in. Print out of duly filled-in application forms are also to be submitted to their respective institutions along with all supporting documents. Only Online application under Post Matric scholarship Scheme will be accepted and no request for an Offline application will be entertained.

Last date for submission of Online application for Fresh and Renewal scholarship by students is 31st October, 2020.

3. Pre-Matric Scholarship: Pre-Matric Scholarship is a Central Sector Scheme. Under this scheme, scholarships are awarded to the meritorious Students from notified minority communities viz. Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhist, Zoroastrians (Parsis) and Jains, pursuing studies in Government or Private School from Class I to Class X who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination are eligible to apply for Pre-Matric Scholarship for the year 2020-21 to be awarded by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India. Income of both parents from all sources should not exceed ₹. 1.0 (Lakh) per annum. Applications for Post Matric Scholarship are to be submitted on-line through the URL www.scholarships.gov.in. Print out of duly filled-in application forms are also to be submitted to their respective institution along with all supporting documents. Only Online application under Pre-Matric scholarship Scheme will be accepted and no request for an Offline application will be entertained.
