WHAT ARE ACADEMIC BANK OF CREDITS (ABC)?

- ABC and Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry (APAAR) is a digital identification system for all students in India.
- Every student in India is required to register for APAAR/ABC ID - a unique 12-digit code.
- This is used to digitally store, manage, and access all their academic credits, including degrees, diplomas, certificates, training details, and co-curricular accomplishments.
- It helps the students for easily transfer from one institute to another or to resume their studies if they choose to leave their courses for a while.

How are credits counted and accumulated?

- Each course has a number of credits assigned to it.
- The student **must** achieve the specified number of credits given in the course.
- Major and Minor courses have 4 credits while VAC, SEC, MDC, AEC have 3 credits assigned to them.
- 1 credit is equivalent to 15 hours of theory learning in class.
- 1 credit is equivalent to 30 hours practical work in labs.
- Credits can also be earned through seminar and paper presentation, group work, assignments, class tests, examinations, community work, field trips, and other academic activities.
- Credits are thus based on Attendance and Participation in academic activities.

HOW TO CREATE AN ABC ID?

- **AADHAR NUMBER AND MOBILE NUMBER LINKED TO AADHAR NUMBER ARE COMPULSORY**
- **DIGILOCKER ACCOUNT IS COMPULSORY**
- DIGILOCKER IS a digitization service provided by the Government of India.
- DigiLocker allows access to digital versions of various documents including driver's licenses, vehicle registration certificates and academic mark sheets which are equivalent to hard copies of the same.
- It also provides 1 GB storage space to each account to upload scanned copies of their documents.

Academic Bank of Credits has been established on the lines of the National Academic Depository (NAD), in the sense, NAD is the backbone of ABC, where the students' academic data are held and academic awards are stored (i.e. storehouse of academic awards). Despite the fact that ABC enables students to register or commence credit transfer, the final outcomes of credit redemption and issuance of certificates, as well as the compilation of award records, are administered by academic institutions via the NAD Platform. Hence being the owner of academic awards, Academic Institutions must mandatorily register themselves under ABC via NAD
